The Asian MetaCentre spurred to a dynamic head start, with our very first APN seminar on Methods of Population-Environment Analysis held in Penang, Malaysia on 10-11th of April, 2000. The meeting took place at the Equatorial Hotel, a five-star hotel about 10 minutes from Penang International Airport.

The seminar was expected to produce a new Population and Development Review special supplement on “Population and Environment: Methods of Analysis”, in current preparation. It immediately preceded a meeting of grantees of the MacArthur Foundation’s “Population-Consumption-Environment Initiative”, also at the Equatorial Hotel. Most of these grantees attended the APN seminar as well.

On the first day of the APN seminar on 10th April saw a good number of invited contributors to the PDR supplement giving presentations. They included Paul Demeny, Partha DasGupta, Warren Sanderson, Wolfgang Lutz, Alexia Prskawetz, Kenneth Strzepek, Leiwen Jiang and Brian O’Neill.

On the second day, there were room for more contributed papers and more informal presentations for all other participants who liked to share their ideas. The seminar also provided room for free format discussions intended to start a process of defining future PDE (Population-Development-Environment) in-depth case studies to be proposed to The Wellcome Trust)
