Context and Scope

The main aim of this workshop is to finalize the projection work started in an earlier training workshop on “Projections of Human Capital” in Bangkok in October 2002. The content of the workshop is two-fold. The first task will be the finalization of the projections of education and human capital in six Asian countries (Indonesia, Malaysia, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand, Vietnam). As new demographic and education data have become available, the projections will be updated so as to reflect the latest development. The second task will consist in writing up for each country, a report on the background of the projections and the projections themselves. These six reports will then become chapters of a volume on the future of education and human capital in East Asia. Sergei Scherbov will oversee the two-week teaching. He will be assisted in the first week by Anne Goujon, and in the second week by Wolfgang Lutz. All three teachers are working at the Vienna Institute of Demography in Vienna and at the International Institute for Applied Systems Analysis.
