**INTERACTIONS OF POPULATION DYNAMICS AND
ENVIRONMENTAL CHANGES: RESEARCH ON THE HEALTH
CONSEQUENCES**

Bangkok, August, 2005

The Asian MetaCentre for Population and Sustainable Development Analysis announces its next APN training workshop entitled “Interactions of Population Dynamics and Environmental Changes: Research on the Health Consequences”. The training workshop will be held at the College of Population Studies (CPS), Chulalongkorn University, during **August 2005 (dates to be confirmed)**.

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This training workshop will examine the health impacts of population and environmental changes as well as appropriate methodologies for research on this theme. The main goal of the workshop will be for participants working in teams of 2 to 3 persons to develop a research proposal for the “Health Consequences of Population Changes” program from the Wellcome Trust or for any other program ready to fund this type of research.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

A total of 5 teams of participants will be chosen to attend the training in Bangkok through a multistage process of selection:

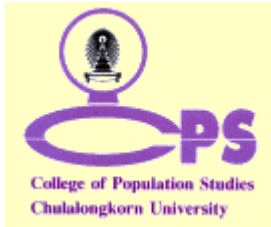
Stage 1: Expressions of interest

Stage 2: Electronic advice and editing

Stage 3: Selection of 5 teams for further editing and final proposal writing in Bangkok

In stage 1, selection will be based on information provided by members of the team. Please find below details of the information you need to provide for “Expressions of Interest”. The organizing committee will select 10 teams among all completed applications received to participate in stage 2.

For stage 2, the 10 teams selected will be invited to work on their draft proposals through an electronic editing by members of the Asian MetaCentre. Through this process, the best 5 teams will be selected for stage 3 while the other 5 will be given a certificate for their participation in the e-editing of grant development.



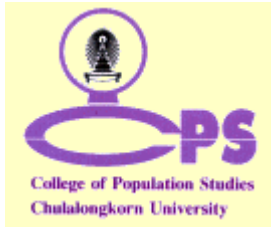

In stage 3, the 5 teams finally selected will be working on their proposals through another round of electronic editing before attending lectures on research methodologies and final proposal writing in Bangkok. At the end of the 5-day workshop, each team should have produced a proposal ready to be submitted to the Wellcome Trust program or any other funding agencies.

The following information will assist those seeking to submit an Expression of Interest (EOI) in response to the above announcement about this training workshop to be held in Bangkok, Thailand. The training aims to recruit five teams of two to three persons working together to develop a research proposal on the health consequences of population dynamics and environmental changes interactions.

Persons who wish to take part in the training workshop should send the following documents:

1. Title of the research proposal
2. Brief description of the problem (100 words)
3. Rationale for doing the research (150 words)
4. Short biography of team members (2 pages/person), including:
 - 4.1 Current position/appointment
 - 4.2 Education/qualification (post-secondary academic records and relevant work experience)
 - 4.3 Research experience
 - 4.4 Publications in journals

The deadline for submission of EOI is **01 March 2005**. Incomplete applications will not be considered. Letters of acceptance to take part of the electronic editing (stage 2 of selection process) will be sent out by mid-February 2005.

For participants selected in stage 3, funding will be covered by the Asian MetaCentre, including round trip economic air ticket to Bangkok, accommodation and per diem. Participants would have to submit their original official receipt before they can claim for airfare reimbursement.
